


AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- To encourage young people to be creative in the use of recycled materials, learning essential skills and techniques along the way and gaining knowledge as to how to creatively design fashionable new clothes and household objects from recycled material.
- To encourage the participation of creative youth activities.
- Crazy Craft Project will allow young people (young women in particular) to initiate and deliver a project that will give them a firm place within the youth club setting. It will give them a goal and an outcome that can be celebrated and highlighted, not only in the club setting but within their communities.
- Crazy Craft Project will be mainly about active participation allowing young people to express their ideas and opinions allowing them to develop the project while meeting the specific aims of the project ie, re-cycling awareness.
- To encourage young people to work with a range of materials, learning key skills and techniques while challenging the concept of re-cycling.
- The project will aim to provide a fun, active and structured programme for young women in particular by addressing and challenging some club practices which may further the exclusion of young women.
- The final goal is to have young people from across all of our clubs to be challenged to create a piece of clothing or object from recycled materials to be presented at a professional exhibition culminating in an award presentation.



PAPER BEAD MAKING

Using everyday materials like glossy magazines, newspapers, wallpaper and corrugated Card our workshop will inspire your young people to turn discarded materials into pieces of jewellery.

Paper beads on elastic to make bracelet or necklace.





Advanced Workshop



Paper beads and jewellery forms created from paper, magazines etc and assembled with upcycled ewellery and beads to form new masterpieces!

DOOR SIGNS

Using recycled pieces of wood normally thrown away our workshop will show you how to make the most from pieces of wood, garden wire and a few buttons from old clothes and ribbon cut offs from inside clothing.

Door signs or kitchen plaques—you decide.


What goes on it is up to you!

Turn jam jars, spaghetti sauce jars and bottles into a makeup brush holder, candle holder or tea light Carriers using old tissue paper from presents, newspapers, old gift wrapping, napkins, left over paint Samples, odd bits of wool, buttons and beads.
